- * The Patriot Papillon Club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.
- * Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after entries have closed. Entries close on Wednesday, August 2, 2023 at 5:00 PM
- * All entries are to be mailed with fees to: Thomas W. Baldwin, 529 Fuller Street, Ludlow, MA 01056-0243. Entries received without fees and/or signature will not be accepted.
- * All checks and money orders are to be made payable to Thomas W. Baldwin, Show Secretary.
- * All checks and money orders MUST be payable in US funds.
- * Entries not on official AKC entry forms are not acceptable.
- * An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.00 service fee for the first entry of each dog and a \$3.50 service fee for each additional entry of the dog All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)
- * The show will be open from 8 AM to 5:00 PM.
- * Dogs may arrive any time before the scheduled time of judging.
- * Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If, because of riot, civil disobedience or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- * Errors on entry blanks are the responsibility of the person making out the form. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such error after the published closing date.
- * Cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Both the Club and the Show Secretary disclaim any responsibility for cash prizes after the judging of the show is over.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

From the East or West: Take the Mass pike to exit 90 (Rts. 290, 395 and 12 South). After you exit the Pike, bear to the right onto Rt. 12 South. Go through the first set of lights, and at the third set take a right onto West Street (strip mall across the street).

* Go about .6 mile, the road takes a sharp left turn under the Pike overpass. We are the next house on the left, multicolor brick, #81. The training center and parking are out back.

From the North: Take 290 to exit 12B (Rt. 12 SOUTH – the exit just before the Mass Pike). When you get to the end of the ramp, take a left. This will take you down to Rt. 12. Take a rt. onto 12. Go through the first set of lights, and at the third set take a right onto West Street (strip mall across the street).

Follow directions from * above.

From the South: Take 395 to exit 11B (Rt 20 west.) Go through the 1st set of lights. At the second set, take a right onto Prospect St. (Corner of Chuck's Steak House and Park-N-Shop). At the end, take a left onto Rt. 12. At the next light take a right onto West Street (strip mall across the street).

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: Entry fee \$35.00. For stud dog and two or more of its get. Stud dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must also be entered in any other class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Produce for Get.

Note ... As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merit of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this

4 Brace Class: (Two, both dogs must have at least one common owner). The fee for the brace as a unit is \$35.00. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. In making entries for 'Brace Class Only', full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a regular class or for Best of Breed Competition and entered as a part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the

space provided for additional classes - 'Brace Class'. If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be so designated - 'Brace No. 1', 'Brace No. 2' etc. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one animal, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

PARADE OF AKC TITLE HOLDERS

A non-competitive Parade of AKC Title Holders. Each dog will be introduced individually in the ring. Castrated dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to participate in the noncompetitive parade. Persons entering dogs should submit the dog's registered name, call name, owner, titles and short resume, to be read during the dog's appearance in the ring.

SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Papillons who, on the day of the show, will be 6 months and under 18 months of age. Dogs may be handled by a handler or agent and all dogs must meet with all other AKC requirements of eligibility. Entry fee is \$20.00 per entry. Dogs entered in Sweepstakes MUST be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Please indicate your Sweepstakes Class, with the age division, in the space provided for "Additional class".

* Chapter 11, Section 8 of the AKC Rules Applying to DOG SHOWS provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

Also, neutered dogs and spayed bitches will be allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. Therefore, neutered dogs and spayed bitches MAY compete in the Veterans Class at this specialty and are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if they win the veterans class.

Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries

Veteran Dogs (For dogs 7 years and over on the day of the show) Veteran Bitches (For bitches 7 years and over on the day of the show)

Spayed bitches and neutered dogs can be shown in the Veteran Classes at Independent Specialties. Winners of these classes are eligible for Best of Breed.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements fo this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check both on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite
 Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete
 against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the
 judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as
 Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.
- * Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- * *A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend.
